RESEARCH: Connect you with the information you need.


- ✓ Respond to your questions and requests for information.
- Straightforward questions
 - How many people are enrolled in Medicaid?
 - What bills have been introduced in past sessions on primary elections?
 - How does the high school graduation rate in NV compare to other states?

- In-depth requests
 - Explain the history of the restriction on disclosing the identity of juveniles who commit serious crimes.
 - Compare Nevada's programs for the homeless with other states.
 - How are other states dealing with driving under the influence of marijuana?

ANALYSIS: Help you understand what you need to know.

- ✓ Examine or summarize bills, laws, and programs in Nevada or other states.
 - What are other states doing to address domestic violence?
 Is there a model law? How does Nevada compare?
 - What does Senate Bill 7 do?
 Are there other ways to address this issue?

- ✓ Identify advantages and disadvantages, or arguments for and against.
 - What might be the benefit of expanding licensure reciprocity for health care providers?
 What problems might arise?
 - How might legalization of recreational marijuana affect Nevada?



ANALYSIS: Help you understand what you need to know.

- ✓ Evaluate the effect of policies and programs.
 - How did the federal Affordable
 Care Act affect insurance
 coverage and the locations in
 which Nevadans receive health
 care services?
 - What is the economic impact of opioid abuse in Nevada?

- ✓ Analyze how policies and programs might work in Nevada.
 - How would changes to the protection of personal information affect local governments or businesses?
 - How would revising the parole system affect the prisons or social services?
