

US 95 NORTHWEST CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS **Phase 3A** PROJECT

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) has announced plans to make improvements at the US 95 and 215 Beltway interchange with the addition of two new connection ramps: one from northbound US 95 to eastbound 215 Beltway, and one from westbound 215 Beltway to southbound US 95. Improvements also include a southbound collector road and a storm drainage system.
