Valley Lions Club, Clark County Farm Bureau, president in 1959; national vice president, Future Farmers of America, 1958-59; member, Southern Nevada Advisory Committee to College of Agriculture, Advisory Committee Southwest Regional Laboratory Educational Research and Development; listed, 1965 Edition of "Outstanding Young Men of America," Eleventh Edition of "Who's Who in the West," Fifth (1968-69) Edition Dictionary of International Biography, 1968 Edition Outstanding Personalities of the West and Midwest; Member, Nevada Assembly, 1961, 1963, 1964 Special Session, 1967, 1968 Special Session, and 1969; at time of original election in 1960 was youngest man ever elected to Nevada Legislature.
