RE: Elko County Report of Services Provided Pursuant to NRS 435.010

Dear Mr. Combs:

Each county has an obligation to provide services for the care, support, and education of children with intellectual disabilities within their county. Specifically, Nevada law provides that:

*"The boards of county commissioners of the various counties shall make provision for the support, education, and care of the children with intellectual disabilities, and children with related conditions, of their respective counties."*  
(NRS 435.010 Section 1).

In the last Legislative session, the Legislature passed a bill requiring each county having a population of 100,000 or less to provide a report containing a description of the county's actions pursuant to NRS 435.010 to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau. Specifically, AB 307 states:


*"The board of county commissioners of each county whose population is less than 100,000 shall submit a report to the Director of the Legislative Counsel Bureau for transmittal to the Legislature, if the Legislature is in session, or to the Legislative Committee on Health Care if the Legislature is not in session. The report must include, without limitation, a description of the action the county is taking to comply with the requirements of NRS 435.010."* (AB 307, Section 3, No. 2).

Elko County is in full compliance with NRS 435.010 and has entered into an Interlocal Agreement with the State of Nevada to provide support, education, and care for children with intellectual disabilities and children with related conditions. Specifically, Elko County, through the State of Nevada, provides the following services:

1. Respite Care – approval on a case-by-case basis
2. Targeted Case Management – all participants
3. In-Home Habilitation – as requested
4. Purchase of Service – case-by-case basis
5. Supportive Living Arrangement – as requested
6. Clinical Services – all participants
