

Report of Test Security Activity for Nevada Public Schools 2016-2017

The Nevada Department of Education establishes test security and administration protocol for the purpose of upholding the integrity of state-mandated assessments, maintaining consistency in test administration, and the validity of scores by means of uniform procedures (NRS 390.105, NAC 389.054). Each year, approximately 300,000 students participate in multiple assessments administered in grades 3 through 8, 10 through 12, and in adult programs. Nearly 900,000 separate tests are administered in over 600 locations. Although the number of tests administered is significant, a total of 369 reported testing irregularities resulted during the 2016-2017 school year.

Based on a review of reported testing irregularities, the following conclusions may be drawn:

- Incidents reported as testing irregularities covered a broad array of occurrences and varying degrees of severity (see table, page 4).
- The 2016-2017 school year experienced a 132% increase in reported testing irregularities from last year. Previously, there were 159 reported incidents for 2015-2016, compared to 182 in 2014-2015, and 224 incidents during 2013-2014.
- Nevada's Summative Assessments, the Criterion-Referenced Tests (CRT) in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics were administered to students in grades 3 through 8. The assessments experienced 195 reported irregularities, accounting for 53% of the total occurrences reported. In comparison, there were 46 incidents—29% of the total occurrences—reported for 2015-2016.
- End-of-Course (EOC) Examinations in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics and Science were administered to students in grades 7 through 12. The assessment experienced 81 reported irregularities (22%), a substantial increase from last year's 11 incidents—7% of the total. Prior to 2016-2017, students in grades 11 and 12 participated in the High School Proficiency Examinations instead of EOC.
- Students in grades 5, 8 and 10 participated in a state science assessment. There were 50 reported irregularities (13.5%), up from 13 incidents last year.
- Adult students participated in the High School Proficiency Examinations (HSPE) in Reading, Mathematics and Science, and the High School Proficiency Examination in Writing. The programs experienced 12 reported irregularities.

- The Nevada Alternate Assessment (NAA) experienced 7 testing irregularities, a slight decrease from 10 incidents in 2015-2016.
- Students with a home language other than English take an English language proficiency assessment, WIDA, to determine the need for supports for instruction and assessments. This year's administration resulted in 22 reported irregularities, up from 10 incidents last year.
- Career and Technical Education (CTE) Assessments experienced 2 incidents.
- The largest number of reported irregularities continues to be student misconduct or cheating, accounting for 149 of 369 incidents (40%), compared to 104 of 159 cases (65%) for last year.
- Improper test administration accounted for 121 occurrences (33%), a significant increase from the previous year's activity of 23 incidents (14%).
- Interruptions in the online testing process were responsible for 32 reported incidents (9%).

Cause and Outcome

- Among the reported irregularities, 188 cases (51%, compared to 33% last year) resulted from teacher error or action, or improper procedures. Mismanagement of student testing tickets, failure to select online accommodations or supports prior to test administration, and log-in errors were the primary causes. Of those 188 cases, 152 resulted in no action from the Department because potential compromise of scores did not occur, and schools or districts developed satisfactory corrective action plans. The remaining 36 cases resulted in invalidations. One case resulted in state-administered corrective action.
- Events beyond the control of the testing environment accounted for the remaining 181 cases (49%). In this category are 149 cases of student cheating or misconduct, and 32 cases of interrupted testing due to student illness or schoolwide technological issues. All instances of student cheating resulted in invalid scores. In the cases involving interruption of the testing process, student tests were unlocked appropriately and students resumed testing.
- It is also noted that 47 (12.7%) irregularities reported in 2016-2017 were for incidents that occurred during the 2015-2016 school year; but reports were submitted after the beginning of the school year.

Additional Examinations

Pursuant to NRS 390.290, there were no additional examinations administered during the 2016-2017 school year.

Unresolved Cases for 2015-2016

At the conclusion of the 2015-2016 school year, three cases were unresolved, pending further information or review. All cases are closed.

Unresolved Cases for 2016-2017

To date, two cases from 2016-2017 are unresolved, pending further information.

Recommendations

In order to decrease the number of testing irregularities and to foster a culture of testing integrity, the Department has completed its second contractual year with a national test security company to provide guidance regarding industry best practices. The following policies are being implemented:

- A Strategic Vision Plan will be published to address key issues related to implementing a set of test integrity and security policies and practices.
- A Communication Plan is being developed to demonstrate the Department's interest, investment and ongoing dedication to test security to various stakeholders, including district leadership, public information officers, students/parents, and the media/public.
- Training for district- and school-level personnel will continue to address the most frequent administration errors uniquely associated with online testing.
- A national test security company is currently customizing a digital intake process that will allow schools and districts to notify the Department and to submit irregularity reports more quickly and efficiently.
- The Department is exploring potential regulatory sanctions for late notification and report submission.

Comparison of Testing Irregularities

The following table provides a comparison of the testing programs to incident type, as described in the narrative on pages 1 and 2. See Attachment A for a complete case-by-case description of occurrences.

Summary and Considerations

The Department strives to elevate achievement results for all Nevada students, and it is therefore critical to ensure the validity of test scores. Valid scores provide an accurate representation of achievement, allowing students to receive the instruction they require to succeed.

In 2016-2017, students participated in online assessments across multiple testing programs, and testing irregularities increased since the previous year. The number of reported testing irregularities has fluctuated somewhat over the past few years, possibly attributed to a changing assessment system. Future test administration training will focus heavily on the specific challenges relevant to online testing.

A Test Security Communication Plan will serve as a test security awareness campaign to the Department's various stakeholders. Feedback will be sought from districts to determine whether they have a clear understanding of the Department's position regarding test security, and if they believe they are equipped to address potential test security incidents.

Additionally, the Department will work closely with districts to ensure that incidents are reported promptly. This will allow both district and Department personnel to accomplish thorough and meaningful investigative work in order to protect the integrity of the state assessment program.

As a culture of testing integrity and test security best practices continues to be built, the Department is hopeful that the 2017-2018 school year will demonstrate a decrease in the number of testing irregularities than in the previous year.
