Meeting was called to order by Chairman James Gibson at 9:35 A.M. Wednesday May 18, 1966 in Ways and Means Committee Room.

Bob Mitchell of Las Vegas Chamber of Commerce observing.

SB 1 - extending time on dormitory furniture. Pozzi moved "do pass. Johnson seconded. All in favor. Mr. Johnson to take on floor.

SB 4 - payment of claims of Carson City for sewer services. Bastian moved "do pass," seconded by Jones. All in favor. Mr. Pezzi to take on floor.

AB 10 - remodeling intensive care wards at State Hospital. Johnson moved "do pass", seconded by Pozzi. All in favor. Mr. Jones to take.

AB 18 - Appropriation bill for session. Discussion by Chairman Gibson as to whether money should be left in to begin next session rather than having an emergency measure each time. He said Senator Lamb would rather not take it out of the general fund.

Young moved "do pass" on 18, seconded by Johnson. Mr. Gibson to take on floor.

Discussion of bond bills to be taken up. Mr. Gibson said AB 16 and 6 go hand in hand. Mention of AB 11.

Chairman Gibson said the committee would hear from Elmo DeRicco on Tahoe Park and Wallace White on transfer of funds into the Welfare Department.

Mr. Pozzi passed out sheets on Ormsby County School Bond issues and discussed same. Chairman Gibson said SB 3 and SB 5 would be looked at this afternoon. He announced a meeting for 2:00 P.M. with the Prison officials.
