

MINUTES OF MEETING - COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION, 55TH ASSEMBLY SESSION
JANUARY 30, 1969

Present: Lingenfelter, Webb, Swallow, Wilson, Tyson, Foote and Prince.

Absent: None.

Chairman Lingenfelter stated that the meeting was convened for further consideration of AB 33, the bill providing compulsory education for handicapped children.

The committee discussed the bill at length. It was developed that the committee endorsed approval of the portions of the measure that would assure that monies allocated for special education be guaranteed for use in that phase only. It was felt that the provisions of the measure making mandatory attendance were not practicable. Also it was felt that the financial support for the measure would have to be modified from the resolution demands of a "double ADA" apportionment. Assemblyman Webb stated that as a member of the Ways and Means Committee he felt that the bill would receive support from that committee if modified.

Assemblywoman Tyson stated that she had received assurance that the Ways and Means Committee would recognize the special education program support in some form.

The committee agreed that the bill would have to be amended and recognized that a move was underway in the Senate to introduce a modified financial program for the support of special education.

The committee agreed to amend AB 33 as follows: Sec.2, line 25, page 2 shall read "accordance with the terms of NRS 392.050 to 392.100". Section 4 on line 37, page 2 shall be deleted.

Webb moved AB 33 amended as stated.
Prince seconded.
Motion unanimously passed.

Tyson moved Do Pass AB 33 as amended.
Webb seconded.
Motion unanimously carried.

The meeting was adjourned.
