MINUTES OF COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS, 55TH ASSEMBLY SESSION, APRIL 14, 1969

Chairman Smith called the meeting to order.

AB 792 requires creation of special committee to study local government problems in Clark County.

Assemblyman Hilbrecht moved Do Pass AB 792. Branch seconded. Motion unanimously passed.

The committee then spent the rest of the meeting going over the amendments to <u>SB 87</u>. Mr. Keith Hendricks of the Firefighters Association and Mr. James Buter of the Nevada State Education Association presented amendments to <u>SB 87</u> which if adopted would make the bill acceptable to those groups without further consideration of <u>AB 127</u>.

Each set of proposed amendments was discussed and the language was adjusted into a revised set. It was agreed to prepare copies of the bill as amended for further consideration.

Bills referred to the committee April 11, 1969:

AB 788 - Committee - Prohibits incorporation of new cities in Clark County without approval of Legislature.

April 12, 1969:

AB 790 - Provides that unexpended moneys appropriated to Bureau of Environmental Health be used to study concentrations of arsenic in public water supplies.

April 14, 1969:

AB 792 given Do Pass in meeting same date. See above.
