The committee met for the second time of the day to continue consideration of \underline{SB} 285 which clarifies jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission over sewer and water supply in general improvement districts.

The committee was asked to reconsider this bill by the Public Service Commission and Mr. Reese Taylor and Mr. Gene Milligan, Chairman and Secretary respectively of the Commission, appeared to advise the committee of the reasons for requesting reconsideration.

Mr. Taylor told the committee that the bill had granted certain regulatory powers without the corelated authority to issue certificates.

Assemblyman Hilbrecht questioned the Commission and Mr. Frank Daykin of the Legislative Counsel with regard to the extent of the powers granted.

Assemblyman Wood said that at this late date he did not deem it expedient to try and amend the bill and if the Commission deemed it necessary the bill should be passed out.

Mr. Taylor and Mr. Milligan were thanked for their presentation and excused from the meeting.

SB 146 established a Central Nevada Resources Development Authority. The committee considered the bill.

Wood moved Do Pass <u>\$B 146</u>. Dini seconded. Motion unanimously passed.

Mr. Curt Blyth was asked into the meeting for his comments on <u>SB 285</u> and advised the committee that he was not informed of the bonding counsel's wishes with regard to the bill.

Wood moved Do Pass SB 285. Motion seconded. Motion passed.
