Up to this point nobody has called the bluff of the federal government.

It was thought that a committee that meets once a year could not be of much good.

Foote discussed <u>AB-590</u> which was defeated today and a notice of reconsideration given, it was asked in the session about Par. 2, Sec. 2, Page 2 of that bill. Other amendments discussed.

Mr. Wahrenbrock is to write a statement explaining this bill and give to the committee.
