<u>SB-398</u> - Requires assessors to provide stickers for campers upon which property tax has been paid

Amend Section 7, lines 45, 46, reducing penalty from "\$3.00" to "\$1.00".

Motion to amend and do pass; seconded; motion carried.

AB-514 - Amends law relating to taxation of mobile homes and requires district attorney to commence action on certain tax delinquencies

Hafen read to the committee the amendments.

AB-694 - Permits use of affidavit of mailing to affirm timely notice to delinquent taxpayers.

Smith moved to do pass; Young seconded; motion carried.

SB-348 - Amends various provisions relating to special fuel

Hafen is to check and see how this bill relates to another.

SB-393 - Provides alternative methods for determining full cash value in assessing tracts for purposes of local improvements

Smith moved to indefinitely postpone; Espinoza seconded; motion carried.

Young said that he was asked whether the bill requesting the change on the ad valorem had been requested; and said that he had requested it.

<u>AB-360</u> - Clarifies methods and procedures involved in valuation and assessment of property

On page 1, line 13, of this bill the Senate has bracketed out "replacement". There was a discussion on this and alternatives suggested.

Jim Haverl is to study the problem and report back to the committee.
