TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD MARCH 26TH, 1969

Chairman Hafen called the meeting to order at 8:00 A.M. bring up AB 269.

Mr. Kean moved to "do pass" AB 269 as amended.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Mr. Davis said that he would check the amendments.

AB 539 was discussed briefly and no action was taken.

Revision of AB 271 was resumed.

Mr. Kean moved to "do pass" to change to commercial vehicle in Section 157 instead of truck.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Section 158 approved as is.

Section 159 approved as is with the exception to cutting out line 17 through 21 of paragraph 4.

Mr. Kean so moved.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Sections 160 to 170 approved as is.

Mr. Ashworth moved to on line 39 put in a period instead of the comma.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Sections 171 to 176 approved as is.

Mr. Kean moved to delete sub section 3, page 30, lines 35 & 36. of Section 176.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Mr. Ashworth moved that they delete line 42 starting with word on, on page 30 of Section 176.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Sections 178 through 189 approved as is.

Mr. Kean moved that on line 35, page 34 the word "highway" be changed to "traveled portion" and also line 49.

Motion seconded.

Motion carried.

Grant Davis was called in at the suggestion of the Committee to see how SB 82 compared with the uniform code. He said that this was part of the Federal request. What they would do each County would appoint a clerk of some sort and this clerk is supposed to be available at all time.

Mr. Ashworth said that he didn't like giving this power to the court.

Mr. Davis said that in some cases some of the counties needed this accitional revenue.

Mr. Howard asked if it could be set up in the Sheriff's office or Justice of the Peace?

Mr. Grant answered that this might be done.

No action taken.

SB 336 which permits department of motor vehicles to retain penalty for late payment of vehicle privilege tax, was brought up for discussion by the Chairman.

Mr. Ashworth moved "do pass" 336.

Motion seconded.

SB 91 was to be discussed next but meeting adjourned at 5:00 P.M. to go into the Assembly.
