MINUTES OF MEETING - WAYS AND MEANS COMMITTEE - NEVADA STATE LEGISLATURE

MARCH 21, 1969

55th SESSION

The meeting was called to order by Chairman R. Young at 10:55 A.M.

Absent: Glaser

Mr. Collins of the Employees Association spoke in favor of the 10.4% recommended salary increase.

Members of the Y.M.C.A. Model Legislature were present to watch Committee procedures.

Mr. Close commented on Spring Mountain Youth Camp and said that it is the State's responsibility not the Counties. The Counties should not have to pick up the tab.

Mr. Ashworth moved that the State shall participate with Clark County on a \$3 to \$1 basis and not to exceed a maximum of \$250,000 State Dollars in the cost of relocating and reconstructing the Spring Mountain Youth Camp. Mr. Bowler seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Ashworth moved that the State participate with the County in the costs of operating the Spring Mountain Youth Camp at \$150 per month per boy but limited to a maximum of 60 boys. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Lowman and Mr. Torvinen were present to speak on A.B. 205, which creates a narcotic and dangerous drug Division.

Mr. Close commented that we should take the Board out and amend it.

Mr. Webb moved that A.B. 205 be reported out with a DO PASS as amended. Mr. F. Young seconded the motion. Motion passed.

A.B. 680 Authorizes election by retiring public employees regarding retirement contributions from accumulated leave payment.

Mr. Webb moved that A.B. 680 be reported out with a DO PASS. Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
