The meeting was called to order by Chairman Roy Young at 5:00 P.M. in the Ways and Means Room.

Discussion was held on A.B. 202 Revises salary and personnel provisions relating to courts.

Mr. Bob Davenport, Clerk of the Supreme Court, sent over to Committee members amendments to this bill stating that it should be amended by deleting Section 1 and 2, and renumbering Section 3 and 4 as Sections 1 and 2, by deleting Section 5 and renumbering Section 6 as Section 3. Also amend the title on the first line by deleting "salary and".

It was noted that this bill will give them the power to hire as many Court Clerks as they need.

Mr. Close stated that we now have five Law Clerks. It was requested by Mr. Close that the bill and amendments be reviewed and reported back to the Committee.

S.B. 306 Increases maximum sum payable for death or disability due to Silicosis.

The Senate Finance Committee sent this bill back with the following recommendation: That \$6,125 be put in instead of \$5,768, as the Ways and Means Committee had recommended.

Mr. Close made a motion that Chairman R. Young write a letter asking for the case history on each person with Silicosis and showing why the are disabled. Having this report ready for the next regular session of the Legislature.

Mr. Jacobsen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Glaser moved to concur with the Senate on S.B. 306 and leave it as \$6,125.

Mr. Ashworth seconded the motion.

Motion passed unanimously.
