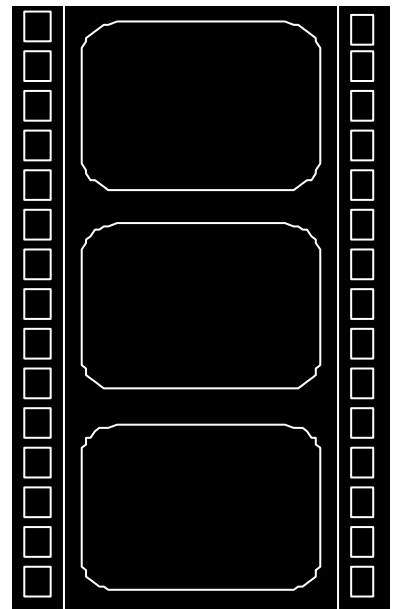
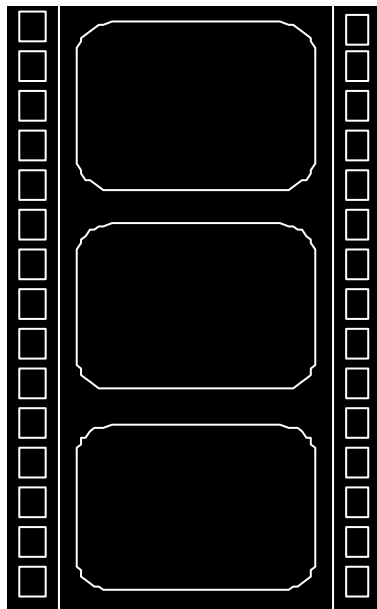
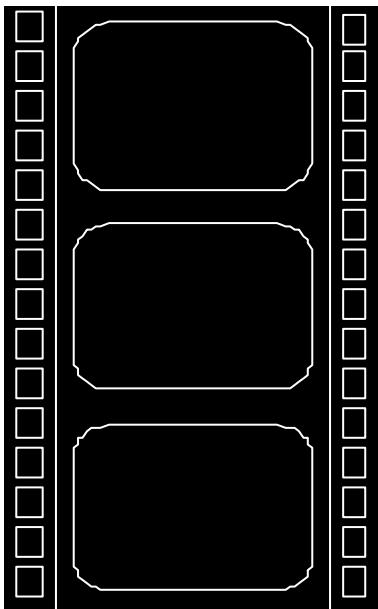

MEMORANDUM

TO: Mr. Ron Sparks, Budget Analyst, Department of Administration
FROM: James C. Lien, Assistant Secretary, Nevada Tax Commission
SUBJECT: Cost of Administering SB 452.

Senate Bill 452 has now been approved by that body, forwarded to the Assembly and assigned to the Commerce Committee, the Honorable James Wood, Chairman. With the possibility that the bill may be given a "do pass" by that Committee, we have prepared a projected cost of administering estimate. Please note that the bill as it now reads would be effective upon passage and approval, and would have a tremendous impact on the agency's current budget.

You may recall that the agency has had limited experience with this type of legislation as the 1965 Legislature passed such an Act, which was then repealed by the 1966 Special Session. It has been determined that two additional personnel would have to be added to the agency due to the volume of work entailed, and the tight time scheduling thereof. The two positions would be a Tax Examiner and a Clerk-Typist for a combined biennium salary cost of \$26,587, as based on the current pay schedule. We have computed the Central Data Processing and MTST costs for the biennium at \$16,208; supplies at \$4,325, and postage at \$17,918. The volume of the latter would be phenomenal, and is required to be certified. Thus, we have estimated that the cost of administering SB 452 for the 1969-71 biennium to be \$64,438.

We believe that the minimum supplemental required to carry the program from the time of enactment to July 1 would be \$9,000.
