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The primary purpose of the Bureau is to assist citizens and officials in obtaining effective State government at a reasonable cost. Schedule 2 shows appropriations in more detail.

At the time the legislature was convened in January, 1957, it was estimated that there would be a balance in the General Fund of \$ 9,527,144.73 on June 30, 1957, before any appropriations made by the 1957 Legislature effective and available prior to that date. (See page 62 of Report of the Legislative Auditor, 1955-1956.) With this estimated balance available, and having the knowledge that the sum would be reduced in an unknown amount by appropriations made by the Legislature available prior to the end of the then present biennium, the Ways and Means and Finance Committees, from the beginning of their deliberations, were of the opinion that any proposed expenditures for capital improvements should come from this balance. Consequently, no bond issues were authorized during the session.

The next problem facing the committees was to reduce the Governor's recommendations for appropriations from the General Fund to a figure that would as nearly as possible and feasible equal the estimated income for the following biennium (1957-1959). General appropriations recommended by the Governor amounted to \$ 45, 593, 925.00. Estimated revenues for the biennium 1957-1959 (excluding property taxes) amounted to \$ 38,066,025.00. Since it was obvious that appropriations for the 1957-1959 biennium would be made in addition to the General Appropriation Act, it was clear that any attempt to bring income and expenditures to a common level would entail much work on the part of the committees.

While it was agreed that no bond issues would be authorized for capital expenditures, it was evident that part of the estimated balance on June 30, 1957, would be used to provide funds to cover appropriations made by the Legislature for the 1955-1957 biennium and also for the 1957-1959 biennium. It was then apparent that it would be impossible for the General Fund to forego all revenue from property taxes. The Legislative Auditor furnished the committees with his idea of the financial picture, with the assumption that the General Fund would collect 28 cents from general property taxes for the biennium 1957-1959. This amount was the rate finally set by law for the state's participation in property taxes. The estimate then made for the 1957-1959 biennium, using the Governor's recommended amount for appropriations, follows:

The 1957 Legislature appropriated, in the General Appropriation Act, the sum of \$39,808,604,37, an apparent reduction of \$5,785,320,63 from the Governor's recommendations. This reduction was achieved chiefly by the reduction of approximately \$3,000,000 in the amount appropriated to the Distributive School Fund; approximately \$1,700,000 for capital improvements transferred from the Governor's recommendations for the 1957-1959 biennium to appropriated funds available prior to June 30, 1957, and a reduction of \$500,000 in the amount appropriated to the University of Nevada. Other reductions in the Governor's requested amount were offset by increasing the appropriations recommended for various agencies.

As is shown on Schedule 6 submitted herewith, at the close of the 1955-1957 biennium the balance in the General Fund amounted to \$9,463,163.30, after all appropriations for the bienniums 1955-1957 and 1957-1959. This shows that the estimates previously made of the balance on hand on June 30, 1957, proved too conservative. The Legislative Auditor's estimates were purposely made on a conservative basis in order that a comfortable balance might remain to begin the 1957-1959 biennium.
