SUBJECT: **Solicitation of Recommendations**

The final meeting of Nevada's Legislative Committee on Public Lands for the 2009-2010 Legislative Interim will be held on Friday, July 30, 2010, in Ely, Nevada. As in previous interims, Committee staff will be reviewing all meeting materials and testimony received in the prior meetings and developing a list of recommendations for possible consideration by the Committee during the work session phase of its final meeting.

The Committee has a limited number of bill draft requests (BDRs) in the 2011 Session but, in addition to BDRs, the Committee may write letters to key individuals and organizations or include positional statements in the Committee's final report. Submission of a recommendation to the Committee does not guarantee its placement on the final work session document.
