To All Interested Parties:

I am writing to invite you to submit any recommendations for legislation that you may want to have considered during the final meeting of the Legislative Committee on Senior Citizens, Veterans and Adults With Special Needs (*Nevada Revised Statutes 218E.750*) this interim. The meeting will be held June 15, 2010, in Las Vegas, with videoconferencing to Carson City. At this final meeting, the Committee will conduct a work session to consider and vote on recommendations that will be carried forward in the form of bill draft requests to the 2011 Legislative Session. The Committee may also take action to write letters or recommendations where bill drafts may not be necessary or appropriate.

I am inviting all interested parties to provide recommendations, in writing, for possible consideration by the Committee during the work session.
