2. The board will, upon request, make available the schedule of fees charged by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards for the examination for registration as an architect and for retaking any part or parts of the examination.

Sec. 2. NAC 623.770 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 623.770 1. [Unless written application for the use is made to and granted] *Upon approval* by the board, [no] *a firm may reproduce any* plan, specification, drawing or other document [issued for official use by a registrant while he is associated with a firm may be reproduced or reused by] that *was prepared by an owner of the* firm for any project after [that] *the owner's* association *with that firm* has ended.
- 2. [In reviewing an application made pursuant to this section, the board will consider the need for and the propriety of the documents to be reproduced or reused and the assumption of professional responsibility for those documents.
- 3.] If the [application] *approval* is granted, the board may make special provision for the stamping of the documents and any modification of the documents it deems necessary.
 - **Sec. 3.** NAC 623.850 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 623.850 1. Because the national standards for education and testing of registered interior designers may not address the technical elements of preparation of designs for alteration or construction of an interior area designed for human habitation or occupancy, the provisions of subsections 2, 3 and 4 govern such designs.
 - 2. Partitions included in a design must:
 - (a) Except if required by subsection 3, exclude a life-safety system; and
 - (b) Comply with the practice of the industry and all applicable codes.
- 3. A registered interior designer may design a door or door frame if the fire-protection rating for the opening of the door or door frame does not exceed 20 minutes. All doors and door frames included in a design must comply with all applicable building codes.
- 4. All ceilings included in a design must be preengineered ceiling systems and the supporting documentation from the manufacturer of the ceiling must be attached to the design.
