# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

### NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION Notice of Hearing for The Amendment of Regulations of The Nevada Board Of Wildlife Commissioners

The Board of Wildlife Commissioners will hold a public hearing at 9 a.m. on August 15, 1998, at the Commercial Hotel, 345 Fourth Street, Elko, Nevada. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of regulation CGR 270 pertaining to Chapter 503 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

#### 1. The need for and purpose of the proposed regulation:

This proposed regulatory action is the update of an existing regulation concerning the classification of fishes and amphibians in Nevada. The status of wild fish and amphibian populations is dynamic, and new information prompts changes in classification. Additionally, changes in federal classification through the Endangered Species Act as amended in 1973 are reflected in state classifications. The proposed revision reflects those changes.
