**EXPLANATION:** 

Amends Chapter 502.361 of NAC by reducing the waiting for application for cow elk tags

from three years to every year.

NOTE: Matter in *italics* is new; matter within brackets [] is to be omitted

**Section 1.** NAC 502.361 is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2 or unless his privilege is limited or

revoked pursuant to law, any person is eligible to apply once for a bull elk tag in any year if

he did not receive a bull elk tag or a replacement tag for a bull elk in the previous 5 years.

Unless his privilege is limited or revoked pursuant to law, any person is eligible to apply once

for an antlerless elk tag in any year [if he did not receive an antlerless elk tag or a replacement

tag for an anterless elk in the previous 3 years].

2. Any person who obtains a bull elk tag or a replacement tag for a bull elk and is

successful in harvesting a bull elk is not eligible to apply for another bull elk tag during the

next 10 open seasons.
