

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

LCB File No. R159-99

Effective March 1, 2000

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 639.070.

Section 1. NAC 639.510 is hereby amended to read as follows:

639.510 *1.* The owner, manager, ~~or~~ operator, *managing pharmacist or pharmacist in charge* of a licensed pharmacy shall maintain in the pharmacy a representative stock of *dangerous* drugs, *controlled substances*, chemicals, biologicals and ~~official preparations,~~ *devices*, in sufficient quantity to provide adequate pharmaceutical services for the people of the community ~~in which the pharmacy is located.~~ *which the pharmacy serves.*

2. The managing pharmacist of a pharmacy:

(a) Is responsible for, and must have knowledge and control of, the acquisition and disposition by the pharmacy of the stock of the pharmacy; and

(b) Shall ensure that the records relating to the acquisition or disposition of the stock of the pharmacy are maintained as required by law.

3. The dangerous drugs, *controlled substances*, chemicals, biologicals and ~~official preparations,~~ *devices kept in the stock of a pharmacy* must meet all of such standards of purity and strength as established by current official compendia or as established on the appropriate labels, and must be properly stored. Any preparation which varies from such standards of purity and strength or becomes unfit for use from deterioration or other cause must not be carried in

stock and must be destroyed in a manner provided by law when so ordered by ~~[the board agent.]~~
