## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

## COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

AUTHORITY: §§1-5, NRS 679B.130 and 686B.1771.

**Section 1.** Chapter 686B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this regulation.

- Sec. 2. "Advisory organization" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 686B.1752.
- Sec. 3. The advisory organization may file with the commissioner a program of group insurance for persons who have not been accepted by an insurer.
  - **Sec. 4.** NAC 686B.800 is hereby amended to read as follows:

686B.800 As used in NAC 686B.800 to 686B.840, inclusive, *and section 3 of this regulation*, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in NAC 686B.805, 686B.810 and 686B.815 *and section 2 of this regulation* have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.

- **Sec. 5.** Section 12 of LCB File No. R091-98, which was adopted by the commissioner of insurance and which was filed with the secretary of state on November 2, 1998, is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - **Sec. 12.** 1. This section and sections 1 to 6, inclusive, of this regulation become effective upon filing with the secretary of state.

- Sections 7 to 10, inclusive, of this regulation become effective on July 1,
  1999.
  - 3. Section 11 of this regulation becomes effective on January 1, [2001.] 2000.
