

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 453.146

Section 1. NAC 453.540 is hereby amended to read as follows:

453.540 1. Schedule IV consists of the drugs and other substances listed in this section, by whatever official, common, usual, chemical or trade name designated.

2. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture or preparation containing any of the following narcotic drugs, including, without limitation, their salts, calculated as the free anhydrous base of alkaloid, in quantities , *is hereby enumerated on Schedule IV:*

(a) Not more than 1 milligram of difenoxin and not less than 25 micrograms of atropine sulfate per dosage unit; or

(b) Dextropropoxyphene (alpha-(+)-4-dimethylamino-1,2-diphenyl-3-methyl-2-propionoxybutane).

3. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture or preparation, which contains any quantity of the following substances, including, without limitation, their salts, isomers and salts of isomers, whenever the existence of such salts, isomers and salts of isomers is possible within the specific chemical designation , *is hereby enumerated on Schedule IV:*

Any material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains any quantity of fenfluramine, including, without limitation, its salts, isomers and salts of such isomers, whenever the existence of such salts, isomers and salts of isomers is possible ~~[.]~~, *is hereby enumerated on Schedule IV*. For the purposes of this subsection, “isomer” includes, without ~~[limitation.]~~ *limitation*, the optical, position or geometric isomer.

5. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains any quantity of the following substances having a stimulant effect on the central nervous system, including, without limitation, their salts, isomers and salts of isomers ~~[.]~~, *is hereby enumerated on Schedule IV*:

FLUSH Cathine ((+)-norpseudoephedrine);
FLUSH Diethylpropion;
FLUSH Fencamfamin;
FLUSH Fenproporex;
FLUSH Mazindol;
FLUSH Mefenorex;
FLUSH Pemoline (including organometallic complexes and chelates thereof);

FLUSH Phentermine;
FLUSH Pipradrol; or
FLUSH SPA ((-)-dimethylamino-1,2,diphenylethane).

6. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture or preparation which contains any quantity of pentazocine, including, without limitation, its salts ~~†~~, *is hereby enumerated on Schedule IV.*
