**Section 1.** NAC 481.005 is hereby amended to read as follows:

481.005 As used in chapters 482 and 483 of NRS, "seasonal resident" means any person who is not a "resident" as defined in NRS 483.141 and who:

- 1. Temporarily resides in this state for a period of at least 31 *consecutive* days in each calendar year;
  - 2. Maintains a temporary residence in this state;
- 3. Returns to the state or jurisdiction of his residence at least one time during each calendar year; and
  - 4. Is registered to vote or pays income tax in another state or jurisdiction.
