

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PUBLIC SAFETY**

Effective August 14, 2000

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: NRS 481.051 and 481.052.

Section 1. NAC 481.005 is hereby amended to read as follows:

481.005 As used in chapters 482 and 483 of NRS, “seasonal resident” means any person who is not a “resident” as defined in NRS 483.141 and who:

1. Temporarily resides in this state for a period of at least 31 *consecutive* days in each calendar year;
2. Maintains a temporary residence in this state;
3. Returns to the state or jurisdiction of his residence at least one time during each calendar year; and
4. Is registered to vote or pays income tax in another state or jurisdiction.
