## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

## DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PUBLIC SAFETY

EXPLANATION - Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets formitted material is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 483.220.

**Section 1.** NAC 483.475 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- 483.475 1. The department will administer [a] an applicable driving skills test to an applicant for reinstatement of his driver's license in, but not limited to, the following instances:
- (a) He has been convicted of six or more moving violations *while operating a*noncommercial motor vehicle during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
- (b) He has been convicted of four or more moving violations while operating a commercial motor vehicle during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
- (c) He has been involved in more than one accident in which he was at fault during the 1-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
  - (c) d He is applying for an upgrade in the type or classification of his license;
- [(d)] (e) He is applying for an additional endorsement not on the license which was withdrawn that requires a driving skills test;
  - (e) (f) The license has expired or has been withdrawn for 1 year or more; or
- [(f)] (g) The license was withdrawn because of the failure of the applicant to complete a driving skills test.

- 2. The department will administer [a] an applicable knowledge test, or a test more specific to a particular classification or endorsement, to an applicant for reinstatement of his driver's license in, but not limited to, the following instances:
- (a) He has been convicted of three or more moving violations *while operating a noncommercial motor vehicle* during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
- (b) He has been convicted of two or more moving violations while operating a commercial motor vehicle during the 4-year period immediately preceding the date of reinstatement;
  - (c) He is applying for an upgrade in the type or classification of his license;
- [(e)] (d) He is applying for an additional endorsement on his license which was withdrawn that requires a knowledge test;
  - [(d)] (e) The license has expired or has been withdrawn for 1 year or more; or
- [(e)] (f) The license was withdrawn because of the failure of the applicant to complete a knowledge test.
  - **Sec. 2.** NAC 483.478 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 483.478 Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (h) of subsection 1 of NRS 62.211 and subsection 2 of NRS 62.2263 [, if]:
- 1. If the department has revoked or suspended a driver's license pursuant to chapter 62, 483, 484 or 485 of NRS, before the reinstatement of the license, the applicant must, in addition to complying with any other conditions required by law:
- [1.] (a) Comply with the requirements for the reinstatement of a driver's license set forth in NAC 483.471 and 483.475;

- [2.] (b) Provide any additional information requested by the department for the evaluation of the applicant's fitness to operate a motor vehicle safely and any other information that the department deems relevant; and
  - [3.] (c) Pay the required fees.
- 2. If the department has revoked, suspended or canceled both a noncommercial driver's license and a commercial driver's license pursuant to chapter 62, 483, 484 or 485 of NRS, the applicant must, in addition to complying with the conditions set forth in subsection 1:
- (a) Comply with the requirements for the reinstatement of the noncommercial driver's license before complying with the requirements for the reinstatement of the commercial driver's license;
- (b) Comply with the requirements for the reinstatement of a driver's license set forth in NAC 483.471 and 483.475 for a noncommercial driver's license, a commercial driver's license, or both;
  - (c) Pay the reinstatement fee for a:
- (1) Noncommercial driver's license if only the noncommercial driver's license is reinstated;
  - (2) Commercial driver's license if only the commercial driver's license is reinstated; or
- (3) Noncommercial driver's license and a commercial driver's license if both are reinstated; and
  - (d) Pay any applicable fee for the type of license issued by the department.
- 3. If the department has revoked, suspended or canceled both a noncommercial driver's license and a commercial driver's license pursuant to chapter 62, 483, 484 or 485 of NRS and an applicant only reinstates his noncommercial driver's license, his commercial driver's

license remains revoked, suspended or canceled until he meets the applicable requirements for
reinstatement of his commercial driver's license.
