

**ADOPTED REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PUBLIC SAFETY**

Effective December 11, 2000

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~omitted material~~ is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 445B.785.

Section 1. Chapter 445B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Before February 1, 2002, a test station which holds a license that was issued before January 31, 2001, shall use a Nevada 94 exhaust gas analyzer or an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer to perform an inspection.

2. A test station which holds a license that was issued on or after January 31, 2001, shall use an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer to perform an inspection.

3. On and after February 1, 2002, a test station shall use an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer to perform an inspection.

4. On and after February 1, 2001, the department will not enroll an exhaust gas analyzer unless it is an NV2000 exhaust gas analyzer.

Sec. 2. NAC 445B.581 is hereby amended to read as follows:

445B.581 An inspection may be performed only at the established place of business by an approved inspector using an exhaust gas analyzer *which is* approved by the department ~~and~~ *and which is the appropriate type of exhaust gas analyzer for the test station pursuant to section 1 of this regulation.*

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF AMENDED REGULATION

The Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety adopted amended regulations which pertained to chapter 445B of the Nevada Administrative Code on November 6, 2000. A copy of the regulations as adopted is attached hereto.

INFORMATIONAL STATEMENT

INFORMATION STATEMENT

The following statement is submitted for adopted amendments to Nevada Administrative Code, Chapter 445.

The Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety noticed and held public hearings on October 30, 2000 and October 31, 2000 to solicit opinion on proposed regulations modifying the emission control inspection and maintenance program regulations.

The notice of public hearing and complete copies of the proposed temporary regulations were posted on or before September 29, 2000 at the Nevada State Library and Archives and each office of the Department of Motor Vehicles and Public Safety. In each county where the Department does not maintain an office, the notice was posted at the main office of the public library.

Public hearings were held on October 30, 2000 in Las Vegas and October 31, 2000 in Reno. In Las Vegas, seventeen people were in attendance, with three people testifying for clarification on Subsection 1, and clarification was given. In Reno, there were twelve people in attendance, no testimony concerning the proposed regulation was taken.

The department will adopt the amended regulations with no changes made. No written submission was received.

There are no adverse economic effects of this regulation to the department, local authorities or the public.

There are no other state or government regulations which the proposed regulations duplicate. to be
