PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

Chapter 449

MEDICAL AND OTHER RELATED FACILITIES

EXPLANATION: Italicized material is new; material in [H] is to be deleted.

NOTE: Only those sections being changed are provided in this document.

FEES

NAC 449.016 is hereby amended.

Section 1. NAC 449.016 License and renewal fees to operate skilled nursing facility, hospital, intermediate care facilities, residential facility for groups, facility for the treatment of abuse of alcohol or drugs, facility for hospice care, home for individual residential care and facility for modified medical detoxification; additional fees; expiration of application for license. (NRS 439.150, 449.037, 449.050, 449.249)

1. Except as otherwise provided in NAC 449.0168, an applicant for a license to operate any of the following facilities must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee of \$50.00 for each bed in the facility and the following nonrefundable fees:

- (a) A skilled nursing facility \$1,200.00
(b) A hospital.....1,200.00
(a) An intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or persons with developmental disabilities..... 750.00
(d) An intermediate care facility, other than an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or persons with developmental disabilities.....1,200.00
(b) A residential facility for groups.....500.00
(c) A facility for the treatment of abuse of alcohol or drugs..... 500.00
(d) A facility for hospice care..... 1,200.00
(e) A home for individual residential care..... 100.00
(f) A facility for modified medical detoxification..... 500.00

2. (a) Except as otherwise provided in NAC 449.0168, an applicant for a license to operate one of the following facilities must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee of \$154.00 for each bed in the facility and the following nonrefundable fees:

- (i) A hospital 5,000.00.
(ii) A rural hospital..... 600.00
(b) An applicant for the renewal of such a license must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee for each bed of \$154.00 and the following nonrefundable fees:
(i) A hospital5,000.00.
(ii) A rural hospital.....600.00

3. (a) Except as otherwise provided in NAC 449.0168, an applicant for a license to operate the following facility must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee for each bed in the facility of \$155.00 and the following nonrefundable fees:
- (i) A skilled nursing facility.....1,200.00
 - (ii) An intermediate care facility, other than an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or persons with developmental disabilities.....1,200.00
- (b) An applicant for the renewal of such a license must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee for each bed of \$155.00 and the following nonrefundable fees:
- (i) A skilled nursing facility.....1,100.00
 - (ii) An intermediate care facility, other than an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or persons with developmental disabilities.....600.00

- ~~[2]~~ 4. An applicant for the renewal of such a license must pay to the health division a nonrefundable fee of \$35 for each bed in the facility and the following nonrefundable fees:

 - ~~[(c)]~~ A rural hospital.....~~600.00~~

 - ~~[(f)]~~ (b) A residential facility for groups.....300.00
 - ~~[(g)]~~ (c) A facility for the treatment of abuse of alcohol or drugs.....300.00
 - ~~[(h)]~~ (d) A facility for hospice care.....600.00
 - ~~[(i)]~~ (e) A home for individual residential care.....100.00
 - ~~[(j)]~~ (f) A facility for modified medical detoxification.....300.00

~~[3]~~ 5. An application for a license is valid for 1 year after the date on which the application is submitted. If an applicant does not meet the requirements for licensure imposed by chapter 449 of NRS or the regulations adopted pursuant thereto within 1 year after the date on which he submits his application, he must submit a new application and pay the required fee to be considered for licensure.

NAC 449.0168 is hereby amended.

Section 2 NAC 449.0168 Fees for modification of certain licenses (NRS 439.150, 449.0305, 449.037, 449.050, 449.150)

1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a holder of a license to operate a medical facility, facility for the dependent, program of hospice care or referral agency who wishes or is required pursuant to NAC 449.190, 449.307, 449.7473 or 449.758 to modify his license to reflect:

- (a) A change in the name of the facility, program or agency;
- (b) A change in the administrator of the facility, program or agency;

- (c) A change in the number of beds in the facility;
- (d) A change in the type of facility licensed or the addition of another type of facility to be licensed; or
- (e) A change in the category of residents who may reside at the facility, must submit an application for a new license to the health division and pay to the health division a fee of \$160.00.

2. An applicant who applies for a license pursuant to paragraph (c) of subsection 1 because of an increase in the number of beds in the facility must pay to the health division:

- (a) A fee of \$160.00; and
- (b) ~~[A fee of \$50.00 for each additional bed in the facility.]~~ *A fee of \$50.00 for each additional bed in the facility for an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or persons with developmental disabilities, a residential facility for groups, a facility for the treatment of abuse of alcohol or drugs, a facility for hospice care, a home for individual residential care, or a facility for modified medical detoxification. A fee of \$154.00 for each additional bed in the facility for a hospital or a rural hospital. A fee of \$155.00 for each additional bed in the facility for a skilled nursing facility or an intermediate care facility, other than an intermediate care facility for the mentally retarded or for persons with developmental disabilities.*

3. If the address of the home office of a home health agency has not changed, a holder of a license to operate a subunit agency or branch office of the home health agency who wishes or is required pursuant to NAC 449.758 to modify his license to reflect a change in the address of the subunit agency or branch office of the home health agency must:

- (a) Submit an application for a new license to the health division; and
 - (b) Pay to the health division a fee of \$160.00.
4. A fee paid pursuant to this section is nonrefundable.
5. As used in this section, “administrator” means the person who is responsible for the daily management of a medical facility, facility for the dependent or program of hospice care.
