

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 639.070.

Section 1. NAC 639.484 is hereby amended to read as follows:

639.484 1. Each original chart order must contain:

(a) The patient's name and the medical facility's or correctional institution's identification of that patient;

(b) The name of the drug, its strength and the route of administration;

(c) Directions for the use of the drug;

(d) The date; and

(e) The practitioner's signature. Any verbal order signed by a practitioner's agent must be cosigned by the practitioner . ~~within 72 hours.~~

2. An original chart order must be maintained in the medical records of the patient along with the record of the administration of the medication.
