**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

NAC 639.330 Registration and reregistration: Continuing education required; submission of proof.

1. Except as provided in NAC 639.335, the board will not issue a certificate as a registered pharmacist to any person pursuant to NRS 639.133, or renew the certificate of any registered pharmacist, until the applicant has submitted proof to the board of receipt of 30 continuing education units within the biennium immediately preceding the current renewal period. Such continuing education units must include not less than:

- (a) Fifteen continuing education units in accredited programs; and
- (b) One continuing education unit in a jurisprudence program *presented and* approved by the board *pertaining to Nevada pharmacy law or pharmacy practice issues. Attendance at four hours of a Board of Pharmacy meeting will be deemed equivalent to one continuing education unit.*

2. No applicant may carry over any excess continuing education units earned in a previous biennium for purposes of compliance with the requirements of this section.

3. Work-related experience acquired in fields other than the practice of pharmacy is not acceptable as credit toward the requirements of continuing education established by NRS 639.2171 to 639.2176, inclusive, and NAC 639.300 to 639.390, inclusive.
