

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE
BOARD OF ARCHITECTURE, INTERIOR
DESIGN AND RESIDENTIAL DESIGN**

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~[omitted material]~~ is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 623.140 and 623.192.

Section 1. Chapter 623 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

If an applicant for registration as a registered interior designer has not obtained a degree in interior design from a program that has been accredited by the Foundation for Interior Design Education Research, the applicant may acquire credit under the following table. The applicant must acquire a total of at least 6 years of credits. At least 2 years of credits must be education credits, and at least 2 years of credits must be training credits. No credit will be given for training experience if the training experience occurred before the applicant had education experience that would qualify for at least 2 years of education credits under the following table.
