

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF
DENTAL EXAMINERS OF NEVADA**

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 631.190 and 631.345.

A REGULATION relating to licenses; establishing the fees that the Board of Dental Examiners of Nevada will charge and collect for the issuance and renewal of certain licenses to practice dentistry or dental hygiene; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 631 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The Board will charge and collect the following fees:

Sec. 2. NAC 631.028 is hereby amended to read as follows:

631.028 1. An application for licensure must be filed with the Executive Director on a form furnished by the Board. The application must be sworn to before a notary public or other officer authorized to administer oaths and accompanied by the fee required pursuant to ~~NRS 631.345.]~~ *section 1 of this regulation.*

2. All such fees must be paid with an instrument which is immediately negotiable.
