A REGULATION relating to licenses; establishing the fees that the Board of Dental Examiners of Nevada will charge and collect for the issuance and renewal of certain licenses to practice dentistry or dental hygiene; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** Chapter 631 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:
