## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §§1 and 2, NRS 385.080 and 391.320.

A REGULATION relating to educational personnel; revising provisions relating to certain disciplinary actions; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** Chapter 391 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

The Board may immediately suspend the license of a person pending a hearing pursuant to NRS 391.320 to 391.361, inclusive, and NAC 391.500 to 391.555, inclusive, if the Board, upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Public Instruction, determines that:

- 1. The licensee was subject to disciplinary action in another state related to his licensure as a teacher or administrator in the other state; and
- 2. Immediate suspension of the license is necessary in the best interests of the pupils in the school district or charter school in which the licensee is currently employed.
  - **Sec. 2.** NAC 391.509 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 391.509 1. The Superintendent of Public Instruction and the holder of a license may agree to modify any limitation of time imposed pursuant to NAC 391.500 to 391.555, inclusive [...], and section 1 of this regulation.

2. A hearing officer may extend any limitation of time imposed pursuant to NAC 391.500 to 391.555, inclusive, *and section 1 of this regulation* if he determines that the extension is appropriate. As soon as practicable after the hearing officer extends a limitation of time pursuant to this subsection, he shall notify the parties, in writing, of the extension and the reason therefor.
