**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF ATHLETIC TRAINERS**

Chapter 640B of NAC

Section 1. *As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise applies, “Board” means the Board of Athletic Trainers.*

Sec. 2. 1. *The Board hereby adopts by reference the standards of professional practice for athletic training and requirements for continuing education adopted by the Board of Certification in its publication *The Professional Practice and Disciplinary Process of the BOC*. A copy of this publication is available from the Board of Certification, 4223 S. 143rd Circle, Omaha, Nebraska 68137-4505, at a cost of \$____. This publication is also available, free of charge, from the Board of Certification at the Internet address <http://www.bocatc.org/athtrainers/STDS>.*

2. *The Board will periodically review the standards of professional practice for athletic training and requirements for continuing education in the publication and determine within 30 days after the review whether any change made to the standards or requirements for continuing education are appropriate for application in this State. If the Board does not disapprove a change to an adopted standard or requirement for continuing education within 30 days after the review, the change is deemed to be approved by the Board.*

Sec. 3. *The passing grades for the examination required by paragraph (g) of subsection 1 of NRS 640B.310 will be determined by the Board of Certification or its successor organization.*

Sec. 4. *As used in NRS 640B.015 and 640B.021, the Board interprets the term “athletic activity” to mean physical, recreational, or occupational activity that require physical skill and utilize strength, power, endurance speed, flexibility or agility.*

Sec. 5. *For the purposes of NRS 640B.015 and 640B.021, an entity is an:*

- 1.** *Intercollegiate athletic association if the entity regulates or sponsors athletic activities between colleges or universities.*
- 2.** *Interscholastic athletic association if the entity regulates or sponsors athletic activities between high schools.*
- 3.** *Professional athletic organization if the entity regulates or sponsors athletic activities by persons who participate in such athletic activities for economic gain or livelihood.*
- 4.** *Amateur athletic organization if the entity regulates or sponsors athletic activities by persons who have never accepted money, or who accept money under restrictions specified by a regulatory body, for participating in such an athletic activity.*
