AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 630.130 and 630.275.

A REGULATION relating to physician assistants; establishing additional grounds for the rejection of an application for a physician assistant's license; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 630.310 is hereby amended to read as follows:

630.310 If it appears that:

- 1. An applicant for licensure as a physician assistant is not qualified or is not of good moral character or reputation;
- 2. An applicant for licensure as a physician assistant has committed any of the acts described in subsection 1 of NAC 630.380;
 - **3.** Any credential submitted is false; or
 - [3.] 4. The application is not made in proper form or other deficiencies appear in it,
- → the application may be rejected.
