

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 679B.130 and 687B.450 (section 1 of chapter 90, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 249).

A REGULATION relating to insurance; requiring certain medical examinations to follow a standard set of criteria; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. Chapter 687B of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

1. Any medical examination required by an insurer pursuant to NRS 687B.450 (section 1 of chapter 90, Statutes of Nevada 2007, at page 249) must follow a standard set of criteria established by the insurer for the medical examination. The standard set of criteria for the medical examination must be consistently applied to each insured.

2. As used in this section, “medical examination” means an examination completed by a licensed physician, including, without limitation, a physical, laboratory tests, radiology or imaging tests, completion of a medical history questionnaire, the taking of physical measurements, including, without limitation, height, weight or blood pressure, or an examination of the heart or other bodily systems or organs.
