AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 284.065, 284.155 and 284.384.

A REGULATION relating to the State Personnel System; revising provisions governing when the resolution of a grievance becomes binding; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

- **Section 1.** NAC 284.697 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 284.697 1. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, the resolution of a grievance is binding : [when:]
- (a) [There] When there is an agreement on the resolution of the grievance between the person filing the grievance and the appointing authority or the designated representative of the employing agency; or
 - (b) [The] On the date the Committee renders a final written decision [...] on the grievance.
- 2. The appointing authority or the designated representative of the employing agency shall submit each proposed resolution of a grievance which has a fiscal effect to the Budget Division of the Department of Administration for a determination of whether the resolution of the grievance is feasible based on [the basis of] its fiscal [effects.] effect. The resolution [is] of the grievance becomes binding only if [it is so found.] the Budget Division determines that the resolution is feasible based on its fiscal effect.
