

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY**

INACTIVE STATUS FOR PHARMACISTS' LICENSES

Section 1. NAC chapter 639 shall be amended to add the following new language:

1. A pharmacist may apply to have his license placed in an inactive status on a form provided by the board. A pharmacist is eligible to have his license placed on inactive status if:

(a) He certifies that he is not and will not be engaged in the practice of pharmacy in Nevada;

(b) Renews his license biennially.

2. A pharmacist who has placed his license on inactive status is not required to complete continuing education as a condition for renewal of the inactive license. If a pharmacist with an inactive license seeks to have his license reactivated so that his license is restored to active status and he can practice pharmacy in Nevada, he must apply to have his license restored to active status on a form provided by the board. Upon receipt of the form provided by the board, board staff shall restore a license to active status if:

(a) The pharmacist has an active license in any other state; or

(b) The pharmacist has provided evidence that:

(1) He has completed 30 hours of continuing education; and

(2) He has successfully taken and passed the written jurisprudence continuing education examination provided by the board.
