## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BUREAU OF SERVICES TO PERSONS WHO ARE BLIND OR VISUALLY IMPAIRED OF THE REHABILITATION DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT, TRAINING AND REHABILITATION LCB File No. R073-08

AUTHORITY: §§1-3, NRS 426.560 and 426.670.

A REGULATION relating to persons who are blind; revising provisions governing the establishment and operation of vending facilities on public property; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** Chapter 426 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

As used in NRS 426.630, the Bureau will interpret "cafeteria" to mean a food-dispensing facility located on public property which is capable of providing a broad variety of foods and beverages, including hot meals, and which may include the use of a line where the customer serves himself from displayed selections. A cafeteria may be fully automated or have servers available and must provide table or booth seating.

- **Sec. 2.** NAC 426.010 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 426.010 As used in NAC 426.010 to 426.500, inclusive, unless the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in NAC 426.015 to 426.055, inclusive, *and section 1 of this regulation* have the meanings ascribed to them in those sections.
  - **Sec. 3.** NAC 426.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

426.030 "Equipment" means items which have a purchase price of [\$100] \$500 or more and are approved by the Bureau as suitable for use in a vending facility. The term includes items which are owned by the Bureau or the operator.
