PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

NOTICE OF WORKSHOP TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division), (775) 687-4270, is proposing the amendment of regulations pertaining to **chapters 688A, 690A and 695C** of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC). A workshop has been set for **9:00 a.m. on August 14, 2008**, at the offices of the Division, **788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701**. Interested parties may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Real Estate Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the workshop is to solicit comments from interested persons on the following general topics that may be addressed in the proposed regulations.

<u>Preneed Insurance</u>. The proposed regulation will amend chapter 688A of the NAC by adding sections to require the use of the 1980 CSO table for the reserving and nonforfeiture values of preneed insurance. The regulation provides a transition period for company implementation.

<u>Consumer Credit Insurance</u>. This regulation amends regulation R014-06 and adds new sections to chapter 690A of the NAC. The purpose of this regulation is to clarify specific sections of NAC 690A and to set forth rates for credit involuntary unemployment insurance products not specifically addressed in current regulations.

<u>HMO Quality and Performance Indicators</u>. The proposed regulation will amend NAC 695C.275 to allow a health maintenance organization (HMO) to be compliant with the reporting of quality and performance indicators to the Insurance Commissioner and to the State Board of Health when the data is actually available.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON REGULATIONS

Notice of Hearing for the Amendment of Regulations of the Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance

The Department of Business and Industry, Division of Insurance (Division), will hold a public hearing at **9:00 a.m. on August 21, 2008,** at the offices of the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. Interested persons may also participate through a simultaneous video-conference conducted at the Bradley Building, 2501 East Sahara Avenue, Real Estate Division Conference Room, 2nd Floor, Las Vegas, Nevada 89104. The purpose of the hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the adoption of the regulations pertaining to **chapter 690A** of the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC).

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

- 1. This regulation is necessary to clarify existing regulations regarding consumer credit insurance and provide rates for credit involuntary unemployment insurance.
- 2. This regulation amends chapter 690A of the NAC to clarify current regulations and also to provide additional guidance regarding prima facie rates for credit involuntary unemployment insurance products not specifically identified in NAC 690A.
- 3. Estimated economic effect of the regulation:

On the business which is to be regulated: The proposed regulation would require an additional cost to affected carriers to file their credit rate.

On the public: The proposed regulation would have no economic impact on the public.

- 4. The Division of Insurance regulates credit insurers that would have to file new rates. These carriers are not small business. The credit insurers may have contracts with small businesses that would have to implement the new rates pursuant to the terms of their contract. The Division of Insurance does not regulate these small businesses.
- 5. The Division may incur some additional expense to enforce the proposed regulation. The additional expense cannot be measured at this time.
- 6. The Division is not aware of any overlap or duplication of the proposed regulation with any state, local or federal regulation.
- 7. This proposed regulation is not required pursuant to federal law.
- 8. There are no federal regulations relevant to these activities.
- 9. The proposed regulation does not establish a new fee or increase an existing fee.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Division may appear at the

scheduled public hearing or may address their comments, data, views or arguments, in written form, to the Division, 788 Fairview Drive, Suite 300, Carson City, Nevada 89701. **Written submissions must be received by the Division on or before August 7, 2008.** If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Division may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, shall issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption, and incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
