## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105, 501.181, 503.660.

A REGULATION relating to wildlife; establishes provisions pertaining to unlawful camping near a water hole or wildlife guzzler.

**Section 1.** Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto section 2, inclusive of this regulation, to read as follows.

Section 2. As used in NRS 503.660, the Commission will interpret "water hole" to mean:

- (a) A small natural or man-made depression in which water collects that can be used by animals as a place to drink.
- (b) An artificial or enhanced natural catch basin designed to collect water for use by wildlife, also known as a wildlife water development or wildlife guzzler.
- (c) "Water hole" does not include a puddle of water which forms from a rainstorm and evaporates quickly or is small enough to step over or shallow enough to walk through.
