

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE
BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets ~~[omitted material]~~ is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 630.130 and 630.269.

A REGULATION relating to perfusion; requiring an original signature on a document submitted to the Board of Medical Examiners by an applicant for a license to practice as a perfusionist; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 630.045 is hereby amended to read as follows:

630.045 1. Any document submitted to the Board by a licensee or an applicant for a license to practice medicine, to practice as a physician assistant, ~~for~~ to practice as a practitioner of respiratory care *or to practice as a perfusionist* must bear the original signature of the licensee or applicant.

2. The Board may refuse to accept any document submitted by a licensee or an applicant *for a license* that does not bear the original signature of the licensee or applicant.

3. As used in this section, “document” means any written submission, notification or communication, including, without limitation:

- (a) An application for a license;
- (b) A request for renewal of a license;
- (c) A request for a change of status; or
- (d) A notification of a change of address.
