## PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE BOARD OF WILDLIFE COMMISSIONERS

## **CGR 404**

EXPLANATION – Matter in *italics* is new; matter in brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 501.105, 501.181.

A REGULATION relating to wildlife; establishes provisions pertaining to radio telemetry and satellite tracking equipment.

Section 1. Chapter 503 of NAC is hereby amended by adding thereto sections 2 through 3, inclusive of this regulation, to read as follows.

Sec. 2. It is unlawful for any person to use radio telemetry or satellite tracking equipment to locate and hunt any wildlife with a radio telemetry or satellite transmitter device attached to them.

- a. The provisions of this section do not apply to an employee or agent of the

  Department who is acting within the scope of their official duties.
- Sec. 3. Any person who kills any wildlife with a radio telemetry or satellite transmitter device attached shall contact the Department and coordinate the return of the radio telemetry or satellite transmitter device to the Department without undue delay.
  - a. It is unlawful for any person to intentionally break, destroy or otherwise damage any radio telemetry or satellite transmitter described in this section.
