~~[NAC 391.173 Qualifications for issuance of unconditional endorsement as professional administrator of school to person who holds conditional endorsement. (NRS 391.019, 391.032)~~

- ~~1. To qualify for an endorsement as a professional administrator of a school, the holder of the conditional endorsement issued pursuant to NAC 391.171 must, within 3 years for which the conditional endorsement is valid:
 - ~~(a) Complete at least 18 semester hours of graduate courses in the administration of a school, including:
 - ~~(1) Administration and organization of a school;~~
 - ~~(2) Supervision and evaluation of instruction;~~
 - ~~(3) Development of personnel;~~
 - ~~(4) Finances of a school;~~
 - ~~(5) The laws that apply to schools; and~~
 - ~~(6) Curriculum; and~~~~
 - ~~(b) Complete:
 - ~~(1) An additional 18 semester hours of graduate courses which may include other courses considered to be part of an administrative program for educators; or~~
 - ~~(2) An additional 12 semester hours of graduate courses which may include other courses considered to be part of an administrative consortium which has been approved by the Department.~~~~~~
- ~~2. If a person who holds a conditional endorsement as a professional administrator of a school completes the requirements of this section and NAC 391.172 within the 3 years for which the conditional endorsement is valid, the Department shall issue an endorsement as a professional administrator of a school that is unconditional on the person's valid license to teach.]~~
