

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF
THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 630.130 and 630.275.

A REGULATION relating to physician assistants; repealing a provision providing for the examination of the competence of a physician assistant under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Section 1. NAC 630.395 is hereby repealed.

TEXT OF REPEALED SECTION

630.395 Examination to test medical competence. (NRS 630.130, 630.275) If there is reason to believe that the conduct of any licensed physician assistant has raised a reasonable question as to his or her competence to practice with reasonable skill and safety to patients, an examination testing the medical competence of the physician assistant may be ordered by the Board or the investigative committee of the Board to determine his or her fitness to practice. A physician assistant who is subject to an examination pursuant to this section shall pay the cost of the examination.
