

# PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

## LCB File No. R105-12

AUTHORITY: §§1, 2, and 3, NRS 442.008; §§1 and 3, NRS 439.150 and 440.120

A REGULATION relating to the examination of infants and taking of blood sample required; fees for registration of birth.

**Section 1.** NAC 440.210 is hereby amended to read as follows:

440.210 1. Registration of birth: Submission of fee to Health Division. (NRS 439.150, 440.120) Each person who is legally responsible for registering the birth of a child shall submit a fee to the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services for each birth as follows:

~~[1. If paid on or before the 30th day after the date of the birth of the child, the fee is \$71.~~

~~2. If paid more than 30 days after the date of the birth of the child, the fee is \$73.]~~

*1. Amount set forth by the Health Division pursuant to this section.*

*2. The Health Division shall establish a birth registration fee based on:*

*(a) A cost analysis to account for the expenses associated with providing newborn screening services.*

*3. The Health Division shall renew and, if necessary revise fees established pursuant to this section:*

*(a) According to generally accepted accounting principles; and*

*(b) As needed, to account for modifications to;*

*(1) The newborn screening program*

*(2) Expansion of the panel of disorders to align with national recommendations of newborn screening tests and testing technologies.*

*4. The birth registration fee established pursuant to this section and any revisions to the fee become effective upon approval of the birth registration fee by the State Board of Health.*

*5. For the purpose of this section, the fee is considered to be the birth registration fee established by the State Board of Health.*

*(a) The fee shall be paid on or before the month following the date of the birth of the child.*

*(b) If paid later than the month following the date of the birth of the child, the fee will increase by \$2.*
