

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE**

AUTHORITY: §1, NRS 587.083.

A REGULATION relating to agricultural seeds; providing that the seeds of mayweed chamomile are not prohibited noxious weed seeds; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Section 1.** NAC 587.173 is hereby amended to read as follows:

587.173 Seeds of the following plants are classified as prohibited noxious weed seeds, the occurrence of which must not exceed the tolerances prescribed by NAC 587.200:

1. Goatgrass, barb (*Aegilops triuncialis*).
2. Halogeton (*Halogeton glomeratus*).
3. Quackgrass (*Agropyron repens*).
4. *Sorghum* spp., perennial, including, but not limited to, Johnson grass, sorghum alnum and perennial sweet sudangrass.
5. Whitetop or Hoarycress (*Cardaria pubescens*).
6. Any noxious weed designated pursuant to NAC 555.010 ~~+~~, *except for mayweed chamomile (Anthemis cotula)*.
