

**PROPOSED REGULATION OF THE  
BOARD OF EDUCATION**

Nevada Department of Education

Proposed Regulation: Approval of Internship Programs

Authority: NRS 385.200 - allows the Superintendent to prescribe regulations for making reports and conducting proceedings.

**NAC Chapter 389 is hereby amended by adding a section to read as follows:**

- 1. A board of trustees of a school district or the governing body of a charter school that chooses to authorize pupils to earn credit for a public or private internship during grade 11 or 12 shall submit to the State Board no more than two times each school year:
  - a. The information required to be prescribed pursuant to Chapter 389.167, section 3; and*
  - b. A statement of how many pupils, if any, earned elective credit through an approved internship program in the prior school year.**
- 2. The State Board shall approve the information submitted at its next meeting after receipt of the information, or shall notify the board of trustees or the governing body of a charter school of changes required for approval.*
- 3. If no changes are made from one school year to the next, a school board or governing body does not need to submit the information in section 1 (a) above, and no additional approval from the State Board is required.*
- 4. Nothing in this regulation empowers the State Board to approve or disapprove individual internships. The Board's authority is limited to approval of a district's program for awarding credits in the specified areas.*
